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to order. We have the Madison Township

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Trustees Budget Public Hearing. This is the

MS. HAMERCHECK: Mr. Pasqualone?

MR. PASQUALONE: Here.

MS. HAMERCHECK: Chief Hager?

CHIEF HAGER: Here.

MS. HAMERCHECK: Mr. Cook?

MR. COOK: Here.

MS. HAMERCHECK: Mr. Wayman?

MR. WAYMAN: Here.

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MS. HAMERCHECK: Mr. Sill?

CHAIRMAN SILL: Here.

Okay. This is the open public hearing for

17

the proposed 2026 budget for Madison Township.

18

All right. Sarah, I guess it's all you.

19

MS. HAMERCHECK: Okay. I have

20

passed out to each of you a copy of the

21

proposed temporary budget for 2026. Now, the

22

final budget will be passed around April of

23

next year, so this is really just a start of

24

the year type of thing, but it is hopefully

25

covering the entire year.

1 Do you want to look it over, if you have
2 any questions, comments, concerns. We don't
3 really have any huge projects planned. This
4 is business as usual. I think the biggest
5 things would be the sidewalk project and the
6 boat ramp.

7 MR. COOK: Correct.

8 CHAIRMAN SILL: And do we have
9 the park budget stuff in here?

10 MS. HAMERCHECK: Yes. The --
11 there is a portion of the general fund, on the
12 second page you'll see it has "parks" next to
13 it, and those are the specific general fund
14 parks.

15 CHAIRMAN SILL: Gotcha.

16 MS. HAMERCHECK: And then
17 scattered throughout the funds that fund the
18 road department you will find also bits and
19 pieces.

20 CHAIRMAN SILL: Paul, I know we
21 kind of talked a little bit about that, but
22 the boat ramp, do you feel pretty, you know,
23 comfortable with the quote we got?

24 MR. COOK: Yeah. It was an
25 engineer estimate. It was usually ten to

1 fifteen high.

2 CHAIRMAN SILL: Okay.

3 MR. WAYMAN: Sarah, does
4 anything stand out above last year, anything
5 earth shattering or --

6 MS. HAMERCHECK: Over that we
7 haven't used from this year --

8 MR. WAYMAN: Uh-huh.

9 MS. HAMERCHECK: -- for next
10 year? So you'll notice that I mentioned it
11 whenever there was a rollover amount.

12 MR. WAYMAN: Okay.

13 MS. HAMERCHECK: But that's just
14 because some projects didn't get to a point
15 where they could be completed, I guess would
16 be the way to say that.

17 MR. WAYMAN: Uh-huh, sure.

18 CHAIRMAN SILL: Chief, anything
19 on here that you had struggles with?

20 CHIEF HAGER: No, no. Like I
21 said, I -- we set our budget so that we have a
22 lot of room, it's gonna be okay.

23 CHAIRMAN SILL: Okay.

24 MS. HAMERCHECK: I guess as a
25 reminder, we are -- we had a twenty percent

1 increase in our health insurance --

2 MR. WAYMAN: Oh, yes.

3 MS. HAMERCHECK: -- so you'll
4 definitely see that in all of these.

5 MR. WAYMAN: Yes, all of the
6 departments.

7 MS. HAMERCHECK: Yeah.

8 CHAIRMAN SILL: Well, I know
9 that was some of the reason we wanted to keep
10 things pretty even-keeled.

11 MS. HAMERCHECK: Yeah.

12 CHAIRMAN SILL: We saw how that
13 handled itself.

14 Any comments, any thoughts?

15 MR. WAYMAN: This is the
16 early one, the temporary budget.

17 CHAIRMAN SILL: Right.

18 MR. WAYMAN: It appears to be
19 -- it appears to be very similar to last year,
20 so it's pretty much got to be in order, I
21 would think.

22 CHAIRMAN SILL: Yeah, seems to
23 be pretty good. All right.

24 MR. WAYMAN: I think we could
25 run with it.

MR. WAYMAN: During the

meeting we'll have a --

MS. HAMERCHECK: Yeah, there's a
resolution.

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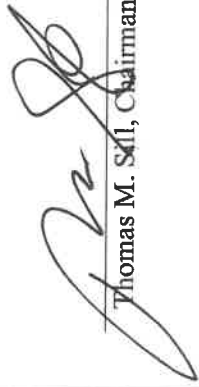
